DELIBERATION No. 59 OF THE STATISTICAL COUNCIL

UPDATE ON THE COMPOSITION OF THE STANDING AND AD-HOC SECTIONS OF THE

STAISTICAL COUNCIL - 2020

Whereas the operating structure of the Statistical Council (hereinafter referred to as the Council) currently in place was approved through Deliberation no. 27 in July 2012;

Whereas, in June 2017, the Ad-hoc Section for Monitoring the Censuses 2021 was created by Deliberation no. 46 of the Council;

Considering the need to adjust the composition of the Standing and Ad-hoc Sections to the organic structure of the 22nd Constitutional Government, specifically the designation of representations of the Government and other Public Administration bodies, but also the new members that join the Council's mandate for the 2020-2022 triennium as personalities of recognised reputation, scientific merit and independence, and the university professors in the area of statistical and econometric methods designated by the Council of Rectors of Portuguese Universities;

The Council, under the terms of paragraph 1 of Article 15 of Law no. 22/2008 of 13 May 2008 and in accordance with Articles 6, 7 and 8 of the Rules of Procedure, at the plenary meeting of 11 December 2020, decided to update the composition of the Standing and Ad-hoc Sections that are part of its structure, as set out in Deliberations No. 46 and 47 of the Council, under the following terms:
