DELIBERATION NO 94 OF THE CONSELHO SUPERIOR DE ESTATÍSTICA (STATISTICAL COUNCIL)

NATIONAL CLASSIFICATION OF OCCUPATIONS/1994

Whereas the competences of the *Conselho Superior de Estatística* (Statistical Council) (hereinafter referred to as the Council) within the scope of the approval of classifications, concepts, definitions and other technical tools for statistical coordination;

Whereas one of the main tasks of the Council is:

"To make maximum use of administrative data for statistical purposes, issuing recommendations particularly on the use of definitions, concepts and statistical classifications in administrative data" Article 10 (1) (d) of Law No 6/89 of 15 April);

Whereas, also, in line with the approved *Linhas Gerais da Actividade Estatística Nacional 1994-1997* (General Guidelines of National Statistical Activity 1994-1997), the first priority within the scope of technical coordination is:

"To adopt new national statistical nomenclatures, interlinked with the latest updated versions of international classifications, in particular Community classifications", namely:

- "... International Standard Classification of Occupations (ISCO) ...".

The *Secção Permanente de Coordenação Estatística* (Standing Section of Statistical Coordination), pursuant to Article 10 (1) (b) and (d) of Law No 6/89 of 15 April, and to paragraph 1 (h) of Deliberation No 92 of the Council, decides at its meeting of 24 February 1995:

- to approve the National Classification of Occupations/1994 (Portuguese acronym: CNP/94), whose structure in annex to this Deliberation forms an integral part thereof, without prejudice to any adjustments deemed necessary, resulting from the conclusions of the Grupo de Trabalho para



Acompanhamento da Utilização da Classificação Nacional das Profissões/94 (Working group for monitoring the use of the national classification of occupations/1994);

- to recommend that the general government services use this classification in all administrative data.
